


How do we develop literacy in Spanish?

- Accuracy
 - grammar is modeled through related short stories, narratives, and other readings, along with gradeappropriate activities
- Narrative Writing
 - reinforced through the use of narratives and student interpretations of Taíno art
- Assessments
 - traditional quizzes and tests
 - or projects via which students must demonstrate, not only the proper use of language, but an understanding of content


Health/Art Co-teaching
